\$10,000	\$ 6.73	\$0.06
\$25,000	\$ 16.83	\$0.28
\$35,000	\$ 23.56	\$0.39
\$50,000	\$ 33.65	\$0.56
\$70,000	\$47.12	\$0.79
\$90,000	\$60.58	\$1.01
\$125,000	\$84.13	\$1.40
\$175,000	\$117.79	\$1.96
